Aneurin Bevan Health Visitor

Health Visitors are part of community health services and work in locally based teams. Health Visitors support the well-being of all children throughout their growing years and are qualified nurses, experienced in child health, who work with a focus on health promotion within Aneurin Bevan's medical, social, education and voluntary services.

Every family with children under five years of age has a named Health Visitor, who can advise parents/carers on a wide variety of health and social issues. The single point of access (SPOA) contact number for Health Visitors is 01633 431685.

Flying Start

Flying Start is the Welsh Government's targeted Early Years programme for families with children under 4 years of age that includes enhanced health visiting, parenting support, speech language and communication support and funded high quality, part-time childcare for 2-3 year olds. This is for 12 and a half hours per week from the term after the child's second birthday until the term after their third birthday. A focus on high quality provision underpins all aspects of Flying Start childcare. Quality childcare contributes to the acquisition of skills and abilities, socialisation, and the ability to play and concentrate. Most childcare settings in Blaenau Gwent are registered to be able to offer Flying Start childcare places.

Families First

Families First is an innovation programme funded by the Welsh Government to help and support families who are facing difficulties through effective multi-agency systems and support. The Families First team in Blaenau Gwent offers different types of support to all families depending on their specific need with a clear emphasis on prevention and early intervention for families, particularly those living in poverty.

As a not-for-profit organisation, the service is dedicated to working as a team with foster carers to help build brighter futures for local children in the Blaenau Gwent area, helping them stay in their familiar local environments, when it's right for them.

Day Nurseries

Day Nurseries provide childcare for children from birth onwards, either for the whole day or part-time. Many Day Nurseries offer a wraparound service to nursery classes in schools as well as offering before/after school and holiday childcare for older children. Day Nurseries must be registered with the Care Inspectorate Wales (CIW) who are the regulatory body ensuring the National Minimum Standards for regulated childcare are met.

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Playgroups mainly look after children aged 2-4 years, usually for 2-3 hours in the morning or afternoon and mainly during term time. Cylchoedd Meithrin are Welsh Medium playgroups which give children an opportunity to experience play through the medium of Welsh, this would benefit your child if you are considering Welsh Medium education for your child, giving them a head start to being bilingual. Playgroups and Cylchoedd Meithrin's if operating for 2 hours or more must be registered with the Care Inspectorate Wales (CIW). CIW is the regulatory body responsible for ensuring the National Minimum Standards for regulated childcare are met. Some playgroups are registered to operate for full days and can offer breakfast clubs, wraparound provision, and after-school care.

Childminders

Childminders are childcare providers who work in their own homes providing a safe and stimulating environment for children to learn and grow, and often provide a wraparound service to Preschool Playgroups, Cylchoedd Meithrins and nursery classes in school.

Childminders are regulated by the Care Inspectorate Wales (CIW) who ensure they meet the National Minimum Standards and Childminders can be registered up to a maximum of 10 children up to the age of 12 years. Of those 10 children, no more than 6 may be under 8 years of age, of those 6 no more than 3 may be under 5 years of age and of those 3 children no more than 2 may be under 18 months (although exceptions can be made for siblings).

Is your child registered with a dentist?

Children under the age of 5 need adult assistance to brush their teeth twice a day using fluoride toothpaste. Establishing good oral hygiene practices early helps children develop strong, healthy teeth. Limiting sugary snacks and drinks, and providing a balanced diet with plenty of fruits, vegetables, and water, also contributes to their oral health.

Baby teeth are prone to decay, which can cause pain, infection, and even impact the development of permanent teeth. Schedule your child's first dental visit by their first birthday and continue with regular check-ups every six months.

Play

Playing is central to children's physical, mental, social, and emotional health and wellbeing and is enshrined in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC). Through play, children develop resilience and flexibility, contributing to physical and emotional wellbeing. Play during the early years of a child's life offers a wide range of benefits and is crucial for well-rounded child development across physical, cognitive, social, and emotional aspects and includes:

- > **Cognitive Development:** Play enhances thinking, problem-solving, and decision-making skills through activities like puzzles and imaginative play.
- > **Social and Emotional Development:** Children learn to interact, share, and empathize while building relationships and understanding emotions.
- > Language Development: Play encourages communication, expanding vocabulary and language skills as children interact and tell stories.
- > **Physical Development:** Physical play, such as running and climbing, supports motor skills, coordination, and overall physical health.
- > **Imagination and Creativity:** Engaging in imaginative play and storytelling fosters creativity and innovative thinking.
- > **Problem-Solving Skills:** Play involves overcoming challenges, promoting adaptability and problem-solving abilities.
- > **Self-Regulation:** Children practice managing behaviour, following rules, and coping with frustration during play.
- > **Confidence and Self-Esteem:** Successful play experiences boost confidence and self-esteem, supported by positive feedback.
- > Cultural and Social Understanding: Play exposes children to diversity, broadening their perspective on cultures and roles.
- > **Bonding and Relationships:** Playtime strengthens bonds with caregivers, siblings, and peers, creating a sense of belonging.
- > **Stress Relief:** Play provides an outlet for stress, helping reduce anxiety and promoting emotional well-being.
- Brain Development: Play stimulates various brain areas, enhancing creativity, problem-solving, and emotional processing skills. The Early Years Childcare and Play Team are committed to deliver play opportunities and events to children throughout Blaenau Gwent which includes Wild Tots and Wild Camps, Open Access Play session during the holiday periods, celebration events such as National Play Day and Santa's Grotto, as well as supporting schools and childcare providers to deliver play within their establishments.

After School and Holiday Clubs

Quality in Childcare Settings

All childcare settings are able to access support, advice and guidance from the local authority. This includes access to bespoke professional learning and visits from local authority officers.

The Early Years Childcare and Play Team and the Flying Start Advisory Team have worked with a range of early years professionals and the childcare settings to develop a tool called 'Quality Matters'. They use this tool to monitor the quality of provision that settings offer and provide support to make any improvements.

We know that high-quality early years childcare provision is essential to children's development. This monitoring and guidance provided by the local authority supports the work the childcare settings do with children at the very beginning of their learning journey, to ensure they have the best possible start.

High quality childcare supports children's:

- > Need to play
- > Natural curiosity to explore and discover new things
- > Sense of belonging and well-being
- > Speech, language and communication skills
- Physical development through opportunities to move around a safe and secure environment
- Social and emotional skills develop as they form new relationships
- > Thinking skills and deepening understanding
- > Creative and problem-solving skills



Part-Time Early Education for 3 and 4 year olds

All children are entitled to a free part-time early education place at an approved education setting from the term after their third birthday until they go into reception class in school. Many parents choose for their children to attend a nursery class in a school, but there is the option to use childcare providers outside of the school base if they are registered education providers.



Healthy and Sustainable Pre Schools Scheme

The Healthy and Sustainable Pre-school Scheme is a national accreditation scheme which acknowledges pre-school settings as contributors to children's health and well-being.

Settings are recognised for their endeavours in promoting nutrition and oral health, physical activity, mental, social and emotional health and wellbeing and are accredited in the following areas called phases.

- > Preliminary
- > Nutrition and Oral Health
- > Physical Activity and Active Play
- > Mental and Emotional Health, Wellbeing and Relationships
- > Environment
- > Safety
- > Hygiene
- > Workplace Health and Wellbeing

The Gold Standard Snack Award

The Gold Standard Snack Award recognises and celebrates a quality snack provision within childcare settings. The award is aimed at all the childcare providers across all local authorities in Aneurin Bevan University Health Board. Settings are supported by Aneurin Dietetics and the local Healthy and Sustainable Pre-Schools Officer to achieve the award by considering the following areas:

- > Snack provision and menu planning
- > Food hygiene and safety
- > The eating environment
- > Food and drink policy

Promoting a whole setting approach to healthy eating including foods provided during celebrations and regular activities. Achieving the award also helps settings meet the Care Inspectorate Wales standards and allows parents and carers to feel confident that the setting they choose for their child is providing the best start in life with regards to high quality food and nutrition. Toileting Support

The Early Years Team is dedicated to supporting parents and childcare providers with toileting assistance to help children learn to use the toilet, an important developmental milestone for toddlers. Childcare providers help children with this learning process by knowing the signs of toilet learning readiness, keeping toileting routines as consistent as possible in their care while children learn how to use the toilet and support parents with any toileting concerns. The Early Years Team has a dedicated ALN Support Officer Lorna Sulway who provides support to both childcare providers and parents. Speech & Language

Children accessing a childcare setting will experience a language-rich environment, where the development of talk and communication is at the heart of provision. Every setting has a member of staff trained in Elklan Speech & Language Support for O-3's and they will be able to monitor how your child's speech, language and communication is developing, discuss this with you and put evidence-based strategies in place to support them where needed. Some settings have also accessed Signalong training, which is a sign system that supports spoken language development. The childcare setting may contact a Speech and Language Therapist for further advice and guidance and will discuss accessing additional support if needed with you. If you have any concerns about your child's speech, language and communication development, you can discuss this with childcare setting staff and your Health Visitor.

Welsh Language Childcare Provision

Cylch Meithrin's provide education, learning and development for children from 2 years old to school age, where they have the opportunity to play, learn and grow through the medium of Welsh.

Additional Needs

As a local authority, we are committed to providing support for preschool children who have additional needs. We recognise that early intervention is crucial for ensuring that these children have the best possible start in life. To this end, we discuss the support needs of a child at the Early Years Additional Needs Support Panel. The panel includes a range of professionals such as health visitors, educational psychologists, local authority experts, and advisory teachers.

The support agreed for children may consist of some additional staffing support for 2-3 year olds to promote school readiness (and for 3-4 year olds if the child receives Childcare Offer), equipment/resources to support their physical and developmental needs or training for staff. Staffing support is provided by skilled childcare practitioners who work with children on an individual or small group basis, for a few hours a week, with the aim of improving their individual needs and reducing the amount of support they may need in school.

We tailor our support in accordance with the Additional Learning Needs Bill in Wales, and we develop individualised support plans called personcentred plans, or PCPs that contain SMART targets, which are reviewed regularly. Our AN Support Officer also offers home and setting visits to offer guidance and advice to ensure that each child receives the best possible support.



Welsh Government Childcare Offer for 3 to 4 Year Olds

Under the Childcare Offer for Wales, you could claim up to 30 hours of early education and childcare per week, for up to 48 weeks of the year. This Welsh Government funded childcare scheme aims to lessen the burden of childcare costs so that you can spend the money you've saved on the things that matter most to you and your family.

The Offer has already helped parents from all over Wales to return to work, increase their hours or work more flexibly. If you're looking for work or thinking about going back into education or training but are worried about childcare costs, this support could make all the difference. Whatever the Offer means for you and your family, don't miss out on your share of this childcare funding.

Universal Credit

If you pay for childcare while you go to work, you may be able to claim back up to 85% of your childcare costs if you are eligible for Universal Credit. Flexible Support Fund

You maybe able to get help from the Flexible Support Fund if you have to pay upfront childcare costs if you are starting work or increasing the hours you work. For further information visit: Universal Credit childcare costs - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)

Tax-Free Childcare

This provides working parents with help towards the cost of childcare. If you are eligible to receive Tax-Free Childcare you will set up an online account. For every £8 you pay into this account, the UK Government will pay in £2 to use to pay your childcare provider. Support for Students

You can apply for Childcare Grant (CCG) to help cover your childcare costs if you're an undergraduate student who has children.
